



PORTO MONTENEGRO

CLEARANCE SHEET

APPROACH

On Entry to Montenegro waters vessels must monitor Montenegro VTS on channel 11 and channel 16. Vessels over 300GT or 50m must call Montenegro VTS on arrival in Montenegro waters.

Speed limit in the bay is 10 knots, and 6 knots in Kumbor and Verige channels.

On Entering Montenegro Waters you MUST proceed directly to a port of Entry

ARRIVAL

On Arrival from foreign Port the Captain must complete the entry process with Customs, Immigration and Harbor Master.

Yachts Must call Porto Montenegro on VHF Channel 71 to announce your arrival – please inform of your last port of call. Our Dock team will direct you to the customs dock. The customs dock is the part of the marina on the North side close to the Yacht Club.

Our Yacht Assist Team are available to assist with all clearance procedures. Note that for out of hours arrivals passport control will be completed and the yacht will remain on the customs dock until the procedure is completed the following morning. HM office working hours are 0800-1900.

VIGNETTE

The vignette is the permit to cruise in Montenegro waters. The fee depends on the length and type of the boat, as well as the period the vignette is valid for. Vignettes can be purchased for 1 day up to 1 year. Payment is made directly to the Harbour Masters office by credit card.

The following documentation is required:

- Boat registry
- Captain's license (including pages where expiry date and limitations are indicated)
- Letter of authorization for the Captain signed and stamped by Owning/Management company
- Evidence of third party liability insurance policy including page where premiums, expiry date and area of coverage is indicated (Mediterranean/Adriatic should be covered, if not available please advise to start procedure for obtaining local insurance)
- Crew list/ Guest list - In excel or word format
- List of tenders with following information: Description and model, Manufacturer, Length, Serial number
- Evidence of insurance for tenders

You might be asked by the Harbor Master officer to present all the originals of the documentation.

TOURIST TAX

Tourist tax is payable after the vignette purchase and is in accordance with size of the yacht and length of stay. It covers all crew on board the yacht during the validity of the Vignette.
